Ask your child about...

Must, Should and Could targets

This week we are introducing Must, Should and Could targets for Numeracy.

This target is addition facts. Here are the should targets for each year group.

Reception: To be able to combine 2 groups of objects

Year 1: To recognise that counting on can be done from any number.

Year 2: To add mentally a one-digit number or a multiple of 10 to any two-digit number.

Year 3: To add mentally combinations of one-digit and two-digit numbers.

Year 4: Add mentally pairs of two-digit whole numbers (e.g. $47 + 58$).

Year 5: To extend mental methods for whole-number calculations (e.g. $2995 + 367$).

Year 6: To calculate mentally with integers and decimals.
