Anti-Bullying

Throughout this term, we are focussing on bullying and its effects with all of our children. We will be talking to them about what bullying is and what to do if they are ever bullied. We will be explaining that bullying is any behaviour that hurts someone else - such as name calling, hitting, pushing, spreading rumours, threatening or undermining someone. It can happen anywhere - at school, at home or online. It's usually repeated over a long period of time and can hurt a child both physically and emotionally.

If you ever have any concerns about bullying in our school, please don't hesitate in talking to your child's class teacher, Miss Thomas or Mrs Lowe. Bullying in any form is not tolerated and any reports will be dealt with immediately.
