#### Applying for a Primary School Place

If you have a child who is due to start primary school in September 2020, you need to submit your application by <u>5pm on Wednesday 15th January</u>.

#### Sickness

If your child has sickness or diarrhoea, they must stay away from school for **48 hours** after the last episode. This is to try and prevent the illness from spreading.
