



To all parents who have registered their interest in school provision as key workers,

The most recent advice on how to limit the spread of COVID-19 is clear. If children can stay safely at home, they should, to limit the chance of the virus spreading. That is why the government has asked parents to keep their children at home, wherever possible, and has asked schools to stay open only for those who absolutely need it.

Only children of key workers – those considered critical to the country’s response to the coronavirus pandemic – and vulnerable pupils will be allowed to attend schools from Monday.

The government has said that “many parents working in these sectors may be able to ensure their child is kept at home”, and that “every child who can be safely cared for at home should be”.

If you believe that you are a critical worker, or have a vulnerable child, we request that you contact us by 12 o’clock today **only if you are unable to have your child at home or cared for safely**. We also request that you inform us of the days on which you will need to use school provision.

You must provide us with evidence from your employer that your role is either frontline or business critical to ensure your child meets the criteria for a key worker place.

We are putting plans in place so that we can support learning at home, however please be aware that we are only able to provide childcare for those children who will be in school.

Our school day will run from 9am – 3pm, and there will be no breakfast or after school clubs. Anyone staying for a full day will need to provide a packed lunch.
