

Please use this guide to help to support your child in their learning at home.

We recommend that children spend half an hour each day completing an English and Maths activity. We then recommend completing 2 other activities.

**English-** children have two pictures to write about and after this could choose their picture to inspire their writing. Children will either bring home a CGP reading comprehension book or selected sheets that they could complete. We still recommend that children keep up their reading 5 times a week.

**Maths-** children all have a CGP arithmetic and reasoning workbook. Children can either work through them or choose areas they feel they'd like to practise.

**Spelling-** children will either have a phonics booklet they can work through or a word mat with our Year 2 words on. Children could practise spelling these and using them in super sentences. Depending on when school closes some children may also have a CGP book with spelling activities in.

**Reading-** we ask that children keep up their regular reading using either their school book or a book from home.

### **Geography**

Next term children will be learning about Madagascar. It's a very exciting topic and we thought children might like to get a head start in their learning.

Children could begin learning about Madagascar using the internet, books, maps or anything else they can get their hands on. They could then present this information in a fun way to bring into school when they get back. You might want to make leaflets, presentations, artwork, fact postcards or cook. Be as creative as you like!
