Over the course of the school closure, we recommend a schedule to ensure all children are continuing to learn and develop their understanding of the Year 4 curriculum. A proposed daily timetable is set out below.

Maths – please complete a Maths task for the duration of **40 minutes**. All worksheets are linked to our current Maths focus – decimals and fractions.

Times tables- please carry out the multiplication check each day, alongside Hit the Button. This should be done for **20 minutes** to help to prepare the Year 4's for the compulsory multiplication check in the Summer term.

English - please complete an English task for the duration of **40 minutes.** Some of the activities are focused on spelling, some are linked to grammar and others are linked to reading or writing.

Reading – please read for at least **20 minutes** per day to help improve fluency and understanding.
