Maths – please complete a Maths task for the duration of 40 minutes . All worksheets are linked to our current Maths focus – decimals and fractions.
Times tables- please carry out the multiplication check each day, alongside Hit the Button. This should be done for 20 minutes to help to prepare the Year 4's for the compulsory multiplication check in the Summer term.
English - please complete an English task for the duration of 40 minutes . Some of the activities are focused on spelling, some are linked to grammar and others are linked to reading or writing.
Reading – please read for at least 20 minutes per day to help improve fluency and understanding. “The more that you read, the more things you will know. The more that you learn, the more places you’ll go.” Dr Seuss
