Year 6 Home Study.

The year 6 students have all been given a home study pack containing work booklets and enrichment study activities to complete during their time off school, with the aim that they spend 2-3 hours each day on set tasks. These tasks can be varied between English, mathematics, reading and historical research about the ancient Maya. Some of the work is in the format of SAT style papers (CGP booklets). The booklets should not be taken in test conditions and you can help your child to complete the work if you wish.

Also included are the word lists for years 3 & 4 and years 5 & 6. Children are now expected to be able to spell all of these words by the time they leave Year 6; they have been a focus in lessons throughout the year and we would like the children to use the sheet for revision purposes. We are aware that some children find spelling extremely difficult and if this is the case they should focus on the year 3 & 4 list only.

We also encourage children to continue practising their times tables and rapid recall of known number facts using the “Hit the Button” app or website.

Easter Holidays – we have also included an Easter revision booklet for the fortnight holiday. The expectation is that the children spend 15-20 minutes each day on a short task, we just want them to keep everything they have learned so far fresh in their minds.

Marking - we will be going through all of the work, with the children, when they return to school, so they must bring all packs back when school reopens.

Remember to keep reading as well!
