Pig 1, 2 and 3 – Pink trousers/leggings and top

Badger 1 and 2 – Black trousers and white top

Bear 1 and 2 – Black or brown trousers/leggings and top

Owl 1 and 2 – Brown or white trousers/leggings and top

Mouse 1 and 2 – Brown trousers/leggings and top

Duck 1 and 2 – Yellow trousers/leggings and top

Bird 1 and 2 – Black trousers/leggings and top

Wolf clubs – Grey trousers/leggings and top

Bugs – Green or black trouser/leggings and green top
