### **2019 outcomes overview**

In 2019 our children achieved the following outcomes in the key school years:

#### **EYFS outcomes**

The number of children achieving GLD (good level of development) was 70%. National average for this was 71.8%.

#### **Year 1 phonics screening**

Corby Old Village Primary: 77%

National pass rate 2019: 85%
