Homework:

Please continue to support your child with homework. Each term, the children will receive a Tic Tac Toe sheet where you colour in a box each time you complete an activity. Any work completed can be submitted by photographs sent to my email address (hmason@covs.northants.sch.uk) or brought into school for us to add to our 'Star' wall. House points will be given for completed homework.

I expect all children to read 5 times per week – this is a really important skill that must continue to be practised so please continue to do this and fill in the Reading Record. I will also send home weekly Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (SPaG) activity mats as well as multiplication *Minute Maths* sheets. This is to help your child improve their fluency in spelling and times tables and we will have regular assessment points throughout the year where they will be tested. House points will be given as rewards.

Catch-up programme and assessments:

Due to Covid 19, the government has suspended Year 2 assessments this year. We will continue to assess as normal and adapt our teaching and learning to suit the needs of the children.

In the Autumn term, the children sat the Phonic Screening Assessment that they didn't have chance to sit it in Year 1 and your child's results will be published in their end of year report. Any children that did not pass the screening test will not resit this term but do receive extra intervention lessons for phonics.

As a school, we have created a catch-up recovery programme where gaps in the curriculum are addressed and revisited as required.
